



Feature	What it does	Cognitive accessibility impact	Productivity benefits for all
Text-to-Speech	Reads on-screen text out loud with dual color highlighting. Users can choose from a wide range of natural-sounding voices powered by advanced voice technology.	Improves comprehension, focus and retention, particularly for those with dyslexia, dyspraxia, or language barriers. Synchronized highlighting further boosts comprehension, engagement, and focus, particularly for autistic and ADHD users.	Speeds up proofreading and review by amplifying literacy errors, and supports multitasking with natural, lifelike voices.
Check It	Advanced spelling and grammar checker with word suggestions and dictionary definitions. It also checks spelling of over 120,000 specialist words within medical, engineering and legal professions.	Increases confidence in the quality of written work, particularly for users with literacy challenges, and non-native English speakers.	By reducing errors and rework, it improves efficiency and the quality of written output.
Similar Word Checker	Identifies homophones and commonly confused words, such as 'there', 'they're' and 'their'.	Increases clarity and confidence, particularly for dyslexic and multilingual users.	Saves time spent proofreading and contemplating over word choice.
AutoCorrect	Automatically, and intelligently, corrects spellings as employees type. *Available with Group and Unlimited licenses	Allows employees to remain focused on their tasks by reducing interruption. This is particularly helpful for ADHD users and those who benefit from reduced distractions.	Works in the background to catch errors automatically, saving time from manual corrections.

Prediction	Intuitively predicts the word the user is typing and the word most likely to follow.	Helps users to keep their flow, which is particularly helpful for those with working memory challenges.	Digital content can be created with fewer keystrokes, increasing speed and accuracy.
Dictionary	Basic dictionary, advanced dictionary and web dictionary provide written and pictorial definitions of words.	Aids comprehension through visual support. Beneficial for employees with literacy challenges, memory difficulties, or those working in a second language.	Employees can quickly understand unfamiliar words without breaking their flow of work. It reduces time lost searching for explanations elsewhere.
Screenshot Reader	Captures 'snapshot' images and text from any document, email or web page, and transforms them into editable and accessible formats.	Captured information is made accessible, meaning it can be accessed by other cognitive accessibility tools such as Text-to- Speech.	Captured content can be easily and instantly reused, saving time from employees having to retype or recreate it.
Dictation	Converts the spoken word into text. Users speak and watch as their words appear on screen.	Allows employees to choose to complete written work verbally, particularly helpful for users with a strength in verbal communication. Being able to get thoughts down quickly also benefits working memory and focus.	Dictation tools allow users to get their thoughts down up to <u>3x faster</u> , saving time on tasks.

Screen Masking	Tints the whole screen in any chosen color, and provides a reading spotlight that can be tailored by color, size and opacity.	Improves text stability for users with dyslexia that often experience distorted text, and eases cognitive load for autistic users and beyond. The reading spotlight also removes distraction and allows users to remain focused on the text they want to consume.	Reduces eye strain and distractions, enabling employees to concentrate for longer and complete reading or data-heavy tasks more efficiently.
PDF PDF Reader	Reads PDF documents out loud, and provides dictionary definitions of any word.	Reinforces understanding and improves retention.	Users can listen and learn as they multitask.
Highlights	Reads PDF documents out loud, and provides dictionary definitions of any word.	Employees can mark key information and collect it in to a single summary document, particularly helpful for those with memory challenges such as dyslexic and dyspraxic users. They can also summarize large documents with ease, reducing cognitive overload for autistic users and beyond.	Speeds up research, reporting, and knowledge sharing by turning scattered information into clear, ready-to-use summaries without extra retyping.
Scan	Converts paper documents and inaccessible PDFs into accessible digital formats.	Ensures all employees can continue to interact with content in the way that suits them best, including neurodivergent employees, rather than being excluded by paper, locked or image-only files.	Saves time by making documents instantly searchable, editable, and easier to work with, reducing manual retyping or workaround tasks.

Translator	Offers written and spoken translations in multiple languages.	Aids comprehension and removes language barriers for those who aren't working in their first language.	Enables clearer, faster communication with global colleagues and clients, without the need to switch tools or delay for translation help.
Voice Note	Offers an alternative to writing comments in documents. Users can record audio notes instead.	Helps those who process ideas better verbally than in writing, reducing pressure on memory and writing fluency.	Speeds up note-taking and idea capture, ensuring nothing gets lost and freeing employees to stay focused on the task at hand.
Vocabulary List	Creates a personalized dictionary or word list.	Reinforces word understanding and memory retention through multi-sensory learning. Helpful for employees taking part in professional development and learning a new topic.	Creates ready-made reference resources, reducing repeated lookups and making learning or training materials easier to absorb.
Audio Maker	Converts text into MP3 audio files, for listening on the move.	Reduces cognitive strain by offering an alternative and convenient way to absorb large amounts of information. Helpful for employees who process information better through listening.	Allows employees to review documents or training material while commuting or multitasking, turning downtime into productive time.
